## **Deltalinq and Rotterdam Climate Initiative to Visit JEMA**

On 2nd October, 2009 Deltalinqs, Rotterdam Climate Initiative (RCI) and JEMA held a short meeting to exchange information on the activities for environmental issues in the electrical industry. For the meeting Chairman of Deltalinqs, Mr. Sluis paid a visit to JEMA together with representatives of RCI and Deltalinqs's member companies. The mission itself consisted of Netherlands Minister of Transport and Rotterdam Vice Mayor although both of them did not visit JEMA. Their purpose to visit Japan was to exchange information with the Government and the related industries.

At first chairman of Deltalinqs Mr. Sluis and president of JEMA Toshimi Hayano exchanged greetings. Then Deltalinqs made a short presentation about their outline of its organization and activities. It emphasized that the private sector itself tackle the target of CO2 reduction by 50% in 2025 from the 1990 emissions level in the Netherlands and thus it promotes saving energy, extended use of renewable energy and activities for low carbon society.

JEMA's president, Toshimi Hayano explained its mission and activities for the electrical industry, emphasizing that the electrical industry tackle a climate change in conjunction with the Government by developing and manufacturing high efficient equipment and that JEMA states its opinions and makes policy proposals to the government in order to promote the development and expanded use of energy-saving electrical machinery.

Finally we discussed and exchanged information each other on the issue.

The meeting was held for an hour but it was very beneficial one for Deltalinqs, RCI and JEMA.
