The Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam to Visit JEMA

On 23rd April, 2009 Mr. Bui Xuan Khu, Permanent Vice Minister of Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam paid a courtesy visit to JEMA with 18 members including deputy director generals of the Ministry.

The purpose of the mission was holding a seminar to attract the foreign direct investment (FDI) in Viet Nam and also visiting the related Japanese industry association to do so.

Permanent Vice Minister Bui Xuan Khu and President of JEMA Toshimi Hayano exchanged greetings and then we exchanged information and opinions on the FDI of electrical machinery industry in Viet Nam. At the meeting especially the Ministry of Industry and Trade in Viet Nam put emphasis on attracting the investment of Japanese supporting industries i.e. parts industries for electrical machineries and home appliances.

Last December Japan signed the agreement between Japan and Viet Nam for an Economic Partnership (Japan-Viet Nam Economic Partnership Agreement). The year 2008 was also the 35th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between Vietnam and Japan. It is expected that the two countries will promote the liberalization and facilitation of trade and both economies will be vitalized through the partnership.
